

My first year as President of Temple Beth El has flown by. As I look back upon my first year, I'd like to share my observations with you.

As President, you are presented with a different vantage point of seeing the synagogue's inner workings. My plan for second half of my presidency is to guide the Board and Congregation in a critical conversation as to where we see the future of Temple Beth El in 2-5 years. TBE Officers and Board have engaged in significant efforts over the past year to assess our building, staff, and funding structures.

This is a transitional time for TBE in many ways. How do we want TBE to fit within our Rochester Jewish community and the Rochester community in general? These are conversations that each and every one of you should be a part of. If I don't hear from you at a future meeting, please contact me directly. I encourage you to take part in the dialogue regarding TBE's future.

#### From the Desk of the Senior Rabbi

#### It's So Hot in Shul on Kol Nidre Night

One of my favorite stories is about Kol Nidre night. It is the story of a young man as he grows up. Each year he would turn to his father during Kol Nidre to ask: "Dad, why is it always shvitzing (real hot) in shul on Kol Nidre? It's always so hot in here, is the A/C not working?" And his father, in a tone of love and understanding, would answer, "It is because all the souls of those who are no longer with us, return tonight and are here with us at this moment. That is why it is so hot."

Though this is anecdote is a work of fiction, I do believe that we are not alone as we pray during the Kol Nidre hour. Every Jew who has come before us and uttered the words is with us in that moment - all those who we have lost this year and in years past, parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, ancestors - they are with us on Kol Nidre. We sense a larger embracing community on that night. A great number of souls together.

Our common history and destiny unify our community. We need the community to cry, to share, and to celebrate on our journey.

Temple Beth El is your community. It is here that many of you became an adult in the Jewish sense (Bar/Bat Mitzvah); it is here others saw your children get married. It is here where we celebrate births, marriage, birthdays, weddings, and anniversaries. In the company of others you find comfort from life's fluctuations and struggles. I know of no other place that can touch us, strengthen our faith, ease our loneliness, soothe our pain of loss, and pull together our broken pieces more than shul. Your shul. Temple Beth El.

As we encounter the New Year 5778 let us feel that warmth, the heat of the holy presence of all who are no longer with us. Let's come together to renew our sanctuary and make it relevant for new clergy and new generation of Jews. Let's come and celebrate the new steps we are taking to provide that warmth we all search for. Help us transform Temple Beth El into the community our children's children will call "my shul," on Kol Nidre night and on every day of the year.

#### Notes From Our Hazzan...

Dear Friends:

I sincerely hope that you are enjoying a wonderful summer, and are finding the time to do those things that have had to wait.

Most of us set goals for this "down time", which most often take the form of reading, traveling, exercising, or learning a new skill. It is our expectation that we will seize the opportunity to reach those goals. Unfortunately, too often, we miss the mark completely or find "reasons" for not

accomplishing that which we set out to do.

Enter the "beat myself up" stage! Our tradition wrestles with this issue as well, and responds in a striking manner. We read, "you are not required to complete the task, but neither are you free to desist from it". We are then encouraged, even pushed to strive, to reach and then extend our reach. Why? Is the objective to frustrate...to accentuate the negative? I do not think so. I believe that our tradition embraces us...knowing only too well that sometimes we do, in fact, miss the mark. Our entire Selichot prayers and Yom Kippur zero in on this idea.

We fully expect to be given the opportunity to ask God for forgiveness for sins we have committed. And we know that we must ask forgiveness directly from other people before we are forgiven. But what about the many times we have been cruel to ourselves? What about those instances when we closed our eyes to reality, or doubted ourselves or assumed that we would not measure up in either a physical or emotional way? Again, Judaism's message is that we are to try...really try to achieve our goal or improve our knowledge and our skill sets. When we are able to walk away from the challenge, win or lose, and know that we gave it our all...only then can we feel our heads upright and our spirits lifted, ready to take on the next one!

# Youth Education Corner

Over the summer, I know that many families are looking for meaningful things to do with their children. I would like to suggest

a few ideas for turning some of our Jewish values into worthwhile activities.

Giving Tzedakah – Create tzedakah boxes out of recycled materials (also fulfills the mitzvah of not being wasteful) and a place to save donation solicitation letters. Children can put change into the tzedakah box before bed each day and at the end of the summer decide which of the places you received solicitations from should receive the money.

Giving tzedakah can also be a donation of time. There are many organizations looking for volunteers. Set aside some time each week to help out. If you need some suggestions for places that allow children to volunteer, contact me in the school office.

Observing Shabbat—Having Shabbat dinner, attending Shabbat services and enjoying family time on Shabbat are all ways to observe Shabbat. A fun project to do before Shabbat is to prepare for Havdallah by going on a walk in nature and finding things that smell nice like flowers, herbs and pine needles. Gather some of these things to use as the besamim (spices) during Havdallah.

Protecting the environment and not being wasteful— If you have a garden, a good project is creating a rain barrel. Children can help decorate a barrel and then water the plants. Rain barrels help prevent soil erosion and sewer overflow (and they cut down on water bills).

Going to the park and picking up garbage is a simple way for children of all ages to help protect the environment. I do, however, recommend wearing gloves when picking up trash.

Feeding the hungry—Our congregation has a community garden; the produce grown in the garden is donated to the Asbury Dining and Care Center. Families are encouraged to get involved in harvesting and caring for the garden. We also collect food for the Brighton Food Cupboard. If you have a home garden, you can also donate a portion of your harvest, either through one of TBE's projects or at one of many food distribution programs throughout the Rochester area.
