PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Kol hakavod to everyone who had helped to make the past year a success. We accomplished much, but there remains much yet to do. In that spirit, I want to take a moment to comment upon Jewish values – specifically the importance of interconnectedness.

Judaism is communal—we cannot be Jewish alone. Rabbi Seth Adelson of Congregation Beth Shalom in Pittsburgh, PA aptly notes that we need a community, a group of people to daven with, a group to celebrate and grieve and eat with, a partner to study Torah with, a hevra qaddisha, a biqqur holim society for visiting the sick, charitable organizations to provide clothing, feed the hungry, shelter the homeless, etc. Our rituals often require a minyan. Our ceremonies require witnesses. Our lives require partners both human and heavenly.

Interconnectedness is a foundational element of everything we do at TBE, and more broadly in the ideating and work we do with our local Jewish agencies and partners. Interconnectedness is also the lens through which we must look when addressing current topics and issues, and in our engagement of people and communities beyond our own.

Rabbi Jill Jacobs writes that although the precise structure of Jewish communities has changed according to place, time, and current interests, membership in a Jewish community has always demanded a sense of shared destiny, manifested in the obligation to care for other members of the community, as well as in the joy of partaking in others' celebrations.

I ask you to think about your TBE connections—perhaps they stem from a multi-generation affiliation with the shul, or maybe you joined to enroll your children in Keshet or Limmud, or you are a transplant to the local area. Now I ask you to consider the possibility of making new connections by becoming more actively involved to tackle some of those topics and issues we face as Jews, and in the planning, vision, and future of TBE and our community. My service as President at TBE is all about the people and the connections I can make with each of you. These connections are important to me and continue to fuel my excitement for the evolutionary path we are on.

One last comment on the subject of interconnectedness, this summer I will begin my two-year Jewish learning and leadership development journey as a member of the Wexner Heritage Program (there are a total of seven TBE members taking part). My sincere thanks to the Farsah Foundation for generously sponsoring this initiative. In addition to developing as an individual, I foresee this as an amazing opportunity to establish new connections and gather innovative programming ideas for TBE. I look forward to sharing more in future KOL articles and in our personal conversations.

Could Summer be a Jewish Summer?

Somehow, summer creeps up on us and catches us unprepared. During the summer months many of us have more time to do the things we have been delaying during the winter months. I have noticed that summer could become the awaited opportunity to enrich your Jewish life.

Our son Ethan is participating in the Journey for Identity (JFI) program this summer. As a young man he shares his time with Israelis in Rochester, Poland and Israel.

Your summer could become a time to increase in your Yiddishkeit. There are a fair amount of things you could learn during these months.

Let me suggest these 5 Jewish activities as you enjoy your summer.

1. Take your Shabbat celebration to your summer vacation. Bring a siddur and candles and wine. Have a shabbas dinner with your summer neighbors. Friday night at home has a special quality all its own. There is a joy and peacefulness that fills the home.
2. Come to shul and have an aliyah.
3. Study Torah. Set aside time to study the Parashah or join me after minyan and we can study together.
4. Learn a new Jewish skill. Learn how to have an aliyah, bless your children, recite the Haftarah or read from the Torah.
5. *Gemilut Hasadim* - "Deeds of Loving Kindness." Do a Mitzvah this summer! Visit or volunteer at Jewish Senior Life.

Collect for a food bank, serve food at a soup kitchen. Every mitzvah leads to another mitzvah.

YOUTH EDUCATION CORNER

As I reflect on my first full year as the Limmud Religious School Director, I would describe it as a year of transition, growth and collaboration. We carried on many of our wonderful traditions such as the Jewish Soldiers Project; Purim Carnival; 3rd Grade Siddur Ceremony; Serving at Asbury Dining and Caring Center; and the 6th Grade Yad Workshop. We also introduced some exciting new programs, a few of which I'd like to highlight.

The Limmud year started with a *Welcome to 5779 and a New School Year* family program at Brighton Town Lodge. We partnered with Temple B'rith Kodesh (TBK) and PJ Library to offer this educational and fun Jewish community program. This event was so successful that TBE and TBK collaborated once again in April to design a special interschool Passover program, *Exodus Experiments*. Together we developed a day that included science, music, art, drama and chocolate, as we explored some of the science behind the Passover story. Limmud hosted our friends from TBK's Hebrew School for this interactive, fun day of learning. By all accounts this was one of the highlights of the year for students and staff alike. We are going to build on this Rochester Jewish community educational partnership in the coming school year and are already working with our TBK and Temple Sinai colleagues to develop 3 interschool programs. Look for more information in the fall.

This past year we also introduced a Friday Night Shabbaton during which students learned in their classes, participated in Friday Night Services, and shared a Shabbat dinner.

We piloted the *TheirStory* oral history project in our 6th grade as part of their B'nai Mitzvah preparation. These students had the unique opportunity to engage in, record, and archive conversations with their parents about their family history, Jewish traditions and so much more.

Our final day of Limmud proved to be a most engaging and fun one. In keeping with our Limmud theme of "*Israel at 70*" every class participated in a schoolwide Israel Fair. Students worked in small groups, pairs or independently to create projects that were tied to their Israel curriculum. The beautiful tri-folds, dioramas, topographical map, presentations, videos and posters reflected our students' knowledge and hard work. The day also included a Maccabiah competition, schoolwide t'fillah and a family picnic. A great time was had by all.

It is very quiet in the hallways of Limmud this summer and we are missing the smiles, laughter and ruach that our students share during the school year. While your children are enjoying some much-deserved relaxation, family vacations, time with friends, and camp, we are busy preparing for the fall. Be sure to mark your calendar as our first day of classes will be on Sunday, September 8.

Temple Beth El remains committed to educational excellence and we are actively recruiting and hiring exceptional Madrichim (Teachers) to join the Limmud staff. If you or someone you know is interested in being Madrich/a (Teacher), a Support Madrich/a (Teaching Assistant or 1 on 1 aide for students with disabilities) or a Youth Group Advisor, feel free to contact me for more information.

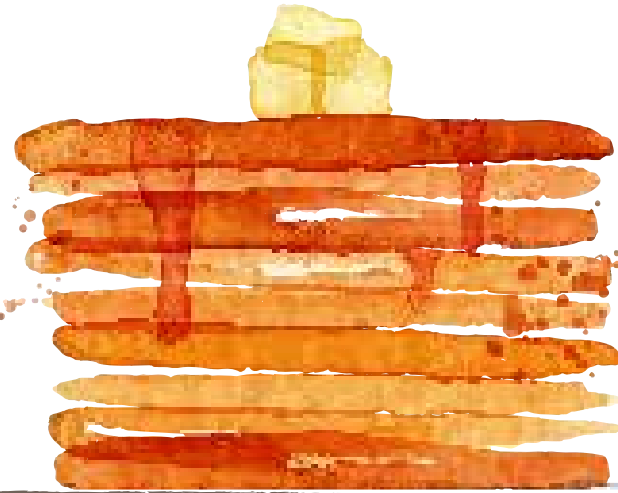
