FROM THE DESK OF THE SENIOR RABBI

Passover: A night to celebrate; a night to eat history.

Passover is a family festival where grandparents, parents, children and friends reenact ancient rituals and for the lack of a better word, all "eat history." In the Torah we are instructed to observe the Passover Festival, as it is written: "It shall come to pass when your children shall say to you, 'what mean you by this Service' and you shall tell the story to your children." The emphasis is on telling and learning. But its emphasis is not on the leader, the head of the household or the rabbi, the whole text of that night, the Haggadah, is intended to build a pathway to a child's heart.

Our tradition is such that there is a foundation upon which human life itself either becomes blessed or loses its possibility for regeneration. During the Passover Sedarim we, as Jews, as parents, as grandparents, have the obligation and privilege to communicate our heritage to our young, to share with them, to respond to them with the values so precious to us.

There is a great Chassidic story about a Rebbe and his disciples. One of the disciples was asked to open the door during the Passover Seder for Elijah, the prophet, to come in. When the disciple returned from opening the door, everyone noticed that his face was quite pale. When asked why he was so moved, the disciple responded, "When I opened the door, I felt that there was a strong possibility for Elijah to come in, and I was afraid." Hearing these words, the Rebbe responded to him "You don't have to be afraid, when Elijah will come in, he will come not through the door, but through your heart."

We hope that Elijah will come to our Passover celebration, to our Seder, because he is the symbol of the reconciliation of the generations. When the generations understand each other, when the young are willing to learn from the experience of the elders, and when the elders are willing to rejoice with the enthusiasm of the young, then, will have arrived to an age of fulfillment.

The Seder table is a table of learning, a table of mutual love and a table of appreciation of the freedom we acquired that night. The Seder is our precious possession we are committed to enhance and expand, let us celebrate with family and friends. In order to realize the thoughts expressed in this article and help you increase your Passover celebration, I would like to invite you to two Passover study sessions. The first one will be about the "Seder and its Symbols" on March 3 at 1:00 pm in the Beit Cafe and the second is titled "No bagels, no pasta, no afikoman?" on March 24 at 1:00 pm in the Beit Cafe.

From our home to yours, Silvana, Ethan and Lara join me in expressing our very best wishes for a Kosher Passover, a happy one. May our learning about Passover and Elijah the prophet enter our homes and our hearts. Amen.



NOTES FROM OUR HAZZAN...

I would like to call your attention to what I know will be a TBE highlight! I hope that you will hold the Shabbat/Weekend of April 20th-22nd and join us for this special musical event.

As you know, each and every year for the past twenty years, we have had the distinct honor to host the Richard W. Briskin Cantor-in-Residence Shabbat/Weekend. We are indebted to Henra, and the entire Briskin family for making this program the continuing success that it has been.

Due to the fact that this is, in fact, our twentieth time featuring students of the H.L. Miller Cantorial School, we will be making this year's concert even more special! Thanks to the generosity of the John Leopold and Martha Delheim Internship Program and Concert Series, we will host not one, but five visiting cantors.

First, a little background information:

John Dellheim (z"l) was a Holocaust survivor who became a pioneer computer programmer at IBM. The John Leopold and Martha Dellheim Endowment Fund initiative includes an internship program that pairs students with mentors in the field, and expands the school's opportunities to teach concert planning, enhance repertoire coaching, and present student performances at IBM. He deeply loved Judaism and Jewish music and endowed the John Leopold and Martha Dellheim Internship Program and Concert Series to bring Western cantorial music around the United States via the mentors, alumni, and students of the H. L. Miller Cantorial School, thereby perpetuating the performance and transmission of Jewish sacred music to future generations.

I will be going to New York to meet and rehearse with our concert participants on April 10th. Hazzan Nancy Abramson is the director of the cantorial school and will be participating in the weekend. She and I will be joined by Hazzanim Matt Austerklein, Anna Silverman, Gil Ezring and Josh Kowitz. I am delighted that Ms. Alla Kuznetsov will, once again be accompanying on the piano.

The Shabbat and weekend will begin with an enhanced presentation of Friday Night Live with our FNL band, followed by dinner. On Shabbat morning we are looking forward to our guest Hazzanim having the opportunity to be a part of our youth services. Rabbi Bitran and I have invited Hazzan Abramson to offer the Dvar Torah at our Shabbat Morning service in our Sanctuary.

On Sunday afternoon, we will present a concert of Jewish Music entitled "Chosen Voices: The story of the Cantor through Music".

The Hazzan Search Committee has been quite busy. We have received several new resumes, bringing our total number of interested candidates to nine. The latest resumes have been thoroughly reviewed by the committee and after much discussion, we have decided to interview three of the candidates via Skype. We had previously had a Skype interview with one of the earlier candidates and are checking his references.

Based on the Skype interviews, we will complete vetting the references for each of the chosen candidates. We intend to bring 3 to 4 candidates to Temple Beth El on weekends based on the various candidates' availability and our availability at TBE.

Working with the clergy, office staff, and the officers, we will put together schedules for each of the visiting Cantors so that all interested congregants including clergy, students, teachers and staff will have an opportunity to hear and become acquainted with each candidate. We intend for you to hear their voices, observe how they conduct Shabbat services and interact with our students and youth. We will make sure that the schedule of such visits is publicized with as much notice as possible.

Lincoln Troop 3:

Celebrating 100 years of Jewish scouting at Temple Beth El

Temple Beth El recognized the benefits of scouting for its youth (boys) within one year of the charter of this great institution. While Temple Beth El Celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2016, the fall of 2017 marked the 100th anniversary of the initial charter of Lincoln Troop 3, considered the 5th oldest Jewish Troop in the US. Lord Baden-Powell founded the movement in England in 1908, in the US it was founded in 1910 and Temple Beth El joined the movement nearly 7 years later.

With a long tradition, over 100 boys have become eagle scouts at Temple Beth El; many of them are your fathers, uncles and maybe some of your children. The tradition continues as our most recent Eagle was Ben Spanjer in 2017! We are proud that Troop 3 is the oldest youth group program at Beth El.

What is the future of Troop 3 and Jewish scouting in Rochester? It is uncertain, but there is some optimism. Recent changes have opened up scouting to more boys and families who were not willing to participate under old outdated policies. For the first time girls will be allowed to join the movement adding a new dimension to the program. Will Troop 3 see its first female Eagle? That remains to be seen. For now however, the bigger issue is adult leadership. Without adults (both parents and friends of scouting), willing to step in, organize and work the program it will be difficult for Jewish scouting in Rochester to sustain itself. So as we enter our next 100 years, let's hope there are those in our community who feel that scouting and Jewish scouting has much to offer our boys and girls. 



TO SELL YOUR HAMETZ

Signature __

The Torah prohibits the ownership of hametz (flour, food or drink made from the prohibited species of leavened grain: wheat, oats, barley, rye or spelt) during Pesah. Ideally we burn or remove all hametz from our premises which may be effected by donations to a local food pantry. In some cases, however, this would cause prohibitive financial loss. In such cases, we arrange for the sale of the hametz to a non-Jew and its repurchase after Pesah. PASSOVER INFORMATION

EREV PESAH SIYUM

The sunrise to sunset ta'anit (fast) bekhorim (of the firstborn), which occurs on the day before Passover, is the only fast that applies to just a segment of the community: all males who are the firstborn children in their families (if the firstborn child is female, the first son born after her is not obligated).

There is a widely practiced exemption: On the principle that fasting is prohibited on a joyous occasion, Judaism allows for anyone who attends a religious feast to forego fasting. It is customary to hold a celebratory meal on the completion of study of a tractate of rabbinic literature, called a siyyum (conclusion). So the sages initiated the practice of studying the end of a tractate after morning services on Erev Pesah followed by a celebratory meal.

At 7:00 am Friday, March 30th, the firstborn in each family is invited to the Siyum B'khorim. Following the meal, there is an opportunity to burn your family's remaining hametz in a bonfire in the TBE Garden.

IS IT KOSHER FOR PASSOVER?

Passover has its own special rules of kashrut. On Pesah, Jews are forbidden from owning or consuming hametz (flour, food or drink made from the prohibited species of leavened grain: wheat, oats, barley, rye or spelt).

Most Ashkenazic authorities have added the following foods (kitniyot) to the above list: rice, corn, millet, legumes (beans and peas; however, string beans are permitted). The Committee on Jewish Law and Standards has ruled unanimously that peanuts and peanut oil are permissible. Sephardic authorities permit the use of all of the above kitniyot.

PERMITTED FOODS:

A. The following foods require no kosher l'Pesah label when purchased before or during Passover: fresh fruits and eggs, fresh fish (whole or gutted), fresh or frozen kosher meat other than chopped meat, whole (unground)) spices and nuts, including whole or half pecans (not pieces), pure black, green, or white tea leaves or teabags, Nestea regular and decaffeinated unflavored tea, coffee (unflavored regular), baking soda and bicarbonate of soda.

- B. The following items may be purchased before Pesah without a Pesah hekhsher but if bought during Pesah require a kosher l'Pesah label: white milk, 100% pure fruit juice, filleted fish, frozen fruit (with no additives), pure white sugar (with no additive), olive oil (extra virgin only), non-iodized salt, quinoa (with no additional ingredients).
- C. The following products require reliable ("kosher l"pesah") certification (regular rabbinic supervision is not sufficient), whether purchased before or during Pesah: all baked goods (matzah, Pesah cakes, matzah flour, farfel, matzfel meal, and any other products containing matzoh), herbal teas, canned tuna, wine, vinegar, liquor, decaffeinated coffee and tea, dried fruits, oils, frozen uncooked vegetables and all frozen processed foods, candy, chocolate-flavored milk, ice-cream, yogurt, cheeses, butter, and soda. Any processed food bought during Pesah must have a ("kosher l"Pesah") certification.
- D. Any detergents, cleaners, etc. which are not a foodstuff and which are not eaten, may be used for Pesah and do not require a special label. These items include: isopropyl alcohol, aluminum products, ammonia, coffee filters, baby oil, powder and ointment, bleach, charcoal, candles, contact paper, plastic cutlery, laundry and dish detergent, fabric softener, oven cleaner, paper bags, plates, wax paper, plastic wrap, polish, sanitizers, scouring pads, stain remover, and bottled water with no additives.
- E. Medicines: Prescription medicines are permitted. Non-prescription pills and capsules are permitted, for liquid medications, check with your rabbi.

BEDIKAT HAMETZ

One of the required holiday ceremonies is Bedikat Hametz, searching for leaven. On the night before the first seder, Thursday, March 29th, we conduct a candle-lit search through our home to ensure that no hametz is still present. It is a brief ceremony in which the entire family can and should participate.

- 1. Make sure that all hametz has been removed or locked away with the exception of what will be needed for the morning.
- 2. Carefully hide some crumbs of bread. This is to insure that the blessing and the ceremony will not be performed in vain.
- 3. Take a candle, a feather or brush, and a box or cloth for the crumbs, and recite this blessing:


 Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheynu Melekh haolam asher kidshanu b'mitzvotav v'tsivanu al biur hametz.

 Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Ruler of the Universe, who has sanctified us with the commandments and commanded us to remove all leaven.
- 4. Perform the search and gather up all the crumbs. Tie them in a bundle which will be burned the next morning. Feel free to (safely) burn it on your own, or use the bonfire at Temple Beth El following morning minyan.
- 5. Recite the following: All manner of leaven which is in my possession, that I have not seen or removed shall be annulled and void of any ownership and considered as the dust of the earth. (The Aramaic for this can be found in the front of your Haggadah.).
- 6. On Friday, March 30th, at or before 10:00 am, burn the leaven and recite the formula below: All manner of leaven which is in my possession, that I have seen or not seen, that I have removed or not removed, that I have destroyed or not destroyed shall be annulled and void of my ownership and considered as the dust of the earth. (The Aramaic for this can be found in the front of your Haggadah.)
