# FROM THE DESK OF THE SENIOR RABBI

# Jewish Prayer; a proposal to a new collective experience

The heart and soul of our people are expressed in our prayers. For centuries, our Jewish ancestors used the act of praying as the sole vehicle to express their intimate feelings about themselves, their fellow human beings and God. A Jewish prayer provides us with an opportunity to reflect and examine ourselves, to consider who we are and what we should become. For the most part, prayers are written in the first-person plural, because as Jews, we are extremely conscious of our fellow Jew. As such, synagogue attendance and participation in communal worship is mandatory, although in the absence of a community one is permitted, with certain limitations, to pray privately. Indeed, we are warned

not even to live in a city that does not have synagogue. Furthermore, we are cautioned that a community without a regular minyan, according to the Rabbis arouses the ire of the Almighty.

Maimonides, the remarkable 12th century Jewish philosopher, law codifier and physician, stresses the importance of communal prayer as one of the responsibilities of members of the communities towards one another:

Prayer of the congregation is always heard by God.

Even if there are transgressors among them, God,
does not reject the prayer of the congregation. Therefore, a person
should associate himself (herself) with the congregation,
and not to recite his (her) prayers for himself (herself) anytime he (she) is to able to pray
with the congregation...

Maimonides Hilchot T'fillah (laws of the Prayer 8:1)

The message is clear to all of us. When acting upon our prayer needs we need to join and come to shul. Temple Beth El is committed to offer religious services to its congregants that create reverence toward God and respond to our congregants' needs.

To make this possible and benefiting from praying together, we would like to hear from you! We are very interested in hearing your suggestions. Let us envision together what Religious Services will be at Temple Beth El in the upcoming years.

# YOUTH EDUCATION CORNER

Spring is in the air and as the trees bud and flowers bloom, our students and staff are anticipating the end of the school year. What an incredible year it has been. Tradition is an important part of Judaism and our religious programming. This year our students once again enjoyed being part of the World Wide Wrap and participated in the Yad Workshop. Our annual Purim Megillah Reading and Carnival lived up to its name as the Happiest Purim on Earth thanks to the many volunteers from the Youth Committee, USY, Kadima, Limmud and Koolanu. The 3rd grade Siddur Ceremony took place during our March Shabbaton. Integrating this rite of passage into a Shabbat morning service was very special as the students used the siddurim they received to lead the congregation in prayer. If you had the privilege of attending this service you witnessed parents presenting their

children with their very own siddurim which were enveloped in covers they decorated together. On the inside cover of each siddur was a personal message to each student from his/her parents. One by one the parents read their heartfelt words to their children as they presented them with their siddurim in front of the congregation. I, like many, was moved to tears by these beautiful and personal exchanges. The smiles on the faces of the children and the sparkles in their eyes as they received their siddurim and listened with pride to their parents remarks was a site to behold. The memories of this special ceremony will surely stay with these families for many years to come.

This year we also introduced some exciting new programming to Limmud. Our First Friday Night Services and Dinners and Family Shabbat Services each featured specific grades and gave our students an opportunity to participate in services. The dinners also provided families with a chance to get to know one another. On February 11th we held a Mishloach Manot Mitzvah Day to give all of our students an opportunity to participate in Tikkun Olam. Our Limmud students baked more than 200 delicious hamantaschen, which they placed in beautifully decorated bags. Parent volunteers helped with every component of this school-wide program including delivering the Mishloach Manot to Jewish seniors in the community. In addition, our Koolanu teens made PB&J sandwiches for guests at Asbury Dining Center. TBE's 6-8th grade students hosted their peers from the First Unitarian Church on March 25th for an Interfaith Learning Program. This is the first of what we hope will be many opportunities for our students to engage with students from our community and other faiths to learn and grow together. In addition, this year the Education Committee invited Limmud madrichim to their meetings to share their respective curriculum and key learnings. These discussions have proven to be both informative and enlightening.




# A Choice for Difficult Times: A New Pall Option for Funerals at Temple Beth El
