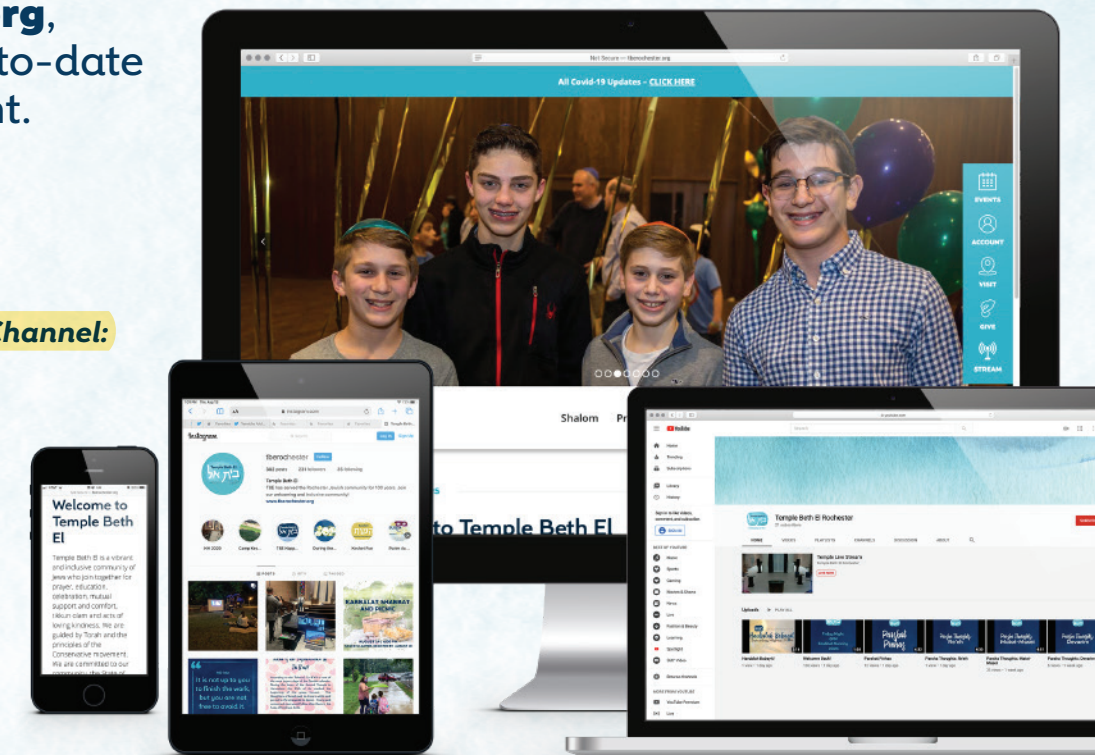

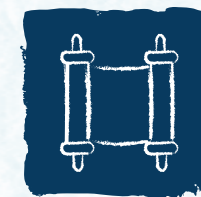

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Yasher Koach to the board, the officers Debbi, Rabbi and all the staff at the synagogue. There are many initiatives under way to strengthen our congregation. Two really stand out for me right now. They are the Be.Wise education program and the upcoming visit from Hazzan Yishai Rackovsky.

The Be.Wise program is a Jewish youth enrichment and engagement program that is an innovative redesign of Jewish education for youth at Beth El. Some time ago the synagogue was the recipient of a grant that helped to fund the engagement of a consultant who seeks to create an innovative youth education program that meets the needs of families who want their children to gain Jewish literacy and to have a positive Jewish learning experience. While the program is moving through what can best be described as early implementation bumps, there is a reason for optimism around the potential the program has for attracting student and family attention. Hazzan Rackovsky's Voice filled the synagogue sanctuary and the Beth El airwaves over the High Holy Days. We are going to have an in-person visit from him over approximately 11 days in November, from the 11th until the 22nd. The visit is the culmination of a part of a clergy search that resulted in several candidates being selected for further review and consideration by the congregation. It would be great for members of the synagogue community to make an effort to meet or at least be present with the Hazan, to make him feel welcome in the synagogue and the Rochester community and to provide feedback to the clergy, search committee, the officers and the board about your impressions. There will be more communication coming about opportunities to meet with Hazzan Rackovsky both in the synagogue and around town. There will also be a formal request for feedback both digitally and in writing.

We have so much to be thankful for and proud of right now.

FROM THE DESK OF THE SENIOR RABBI

Life's Large and Small Problems

Some time ago I read a wonderful sermon by Rabbi Morris Adler, (may his memory be always be associated with a blessing) In that sermon, Rabbi Adler quoted an interview with a person who had just walked across America. Stationed in New York reporters asked this person what was the thing that had bothered him most during his three thousand-mile journey. They expected him to say the Rocky Mountain range, the Mississippi River, or the crowded cities. Instead, this athlete said that the greatest obstacle he had encountered were the pebbles in his shoes. The pebbles in his shoes plagued him all the way. To Rabbi Adler, and many years later, to me, this finding has a profound truth. I would say how lucky this man was that he missed the big problems, the unbearable issues of life. He had little problems to take care of as he walked, nothing major, he just kept on going, cleaning his shoes, as he continued his trip. However, the more I think about it, I realize that in our lives we tend to do exactly the opposite. We concentrate on major issues and forget the pebbles in our shoes, the little deficiencies, the minor weaknesses, and the small transgressions here and there. We have immunized our conscience. We no longer pay attention to the unimportant obstacles as we plough through the path of a better life. Sometimes we voice our opinion against the big injustices of life, the major events. The small ones are not even mentioned. We tend to forget that throughout life we have allowed the small problems to erode our character. We permit the years to eat away at our personality. We are strong enough to resist the large temptations. When was the last time you robbed a bank, burned a house, or hit your friend? You could say to yourself, "I have resisted these large temptations" Please, don't make the mistake that because you have not done any of these things you are OK. It is the small temptations, the little hypocrisies, and the little duplicities, which really destroy us. We lose our Judaism by small doses of abandonment. Let me tell you that if we observe Judaism only in dramatic moments, only when we need a Minyan, only when we celebrate a life cycle event, that erodes our Judaism. Every time we lower the thresholds of observance, time dedicated to Jewish causes, commitment and compassion, the great casualty ends up being our character.

We are accustomed to think the monumental issues of our times at the High Holy Days; to ponder once again those eternal problems of human existence. Now that the HHD are in the rear view mirror and Hanukkah is approaching let us consider each, in the privacy of his/her own heart and mind, the pebbles in our shoes. Let us arm ourselves against these minor transgression. Let us fix them along the way. Perhaps we shall achieve a major triumph of character and of human dignity.

EARLY CHILDHOOD UPDATE

Starting a new school year always reminds me of the Joni Mitchell song, “The Circle Game”. When parents let their children out to wander, they watch their excitement and fears as they enter those doors. It doesn’t matter if it is their first time dropping off as a Pitzel or their final year in Gan Gadol, our prekindergarten classroom. I’m also in awe of how much the children grow each year, and with each season they seem to gain a few more inches, a few more words, and a whole new set of skills.

The start of our school year began with transitioning through the shortened weeks of the high holidays, new faces and teachers, and new routines. Our classes circled their way through learning about the high holidays, and we incorporated Torah parades, Sukkah visits, and other special events. We had Etrogs with Ima virtually due to the rain, and we were able to have Apples with Abba in person, thanks to the warm October surprise. We welcomed several special guests safely outside as we did crafts, sang songs, and read stories.

We welcomed in a new music program called Tkiya, which is an interactive Jewish music experience. Josh Mayheim, a Music Therapy Grad student at Nazareth, has brought music alive as our children are interacting with both traditional and new Jewish music.

Our Gan Gadol class began a partnership with Hillel Community Day school called the ¼ Club. This is something we did last year, but are doing slightly differently this year. Each child is paired with a special buddy that is a fourth or fifth grader from Hillel School that they meet with over Moodle. The 4th and 5th graders teach our students reading skills, Hebrew, literacy skills, as well as what it is like to be in school. Our children are learning computer and technology skills, and tapping into their engineering side.

We continued our new Sunny Sundays program with two more sessions. Each time brought even more young families together. While their children played on the playground, families were able to socialize with other Jewish parents. We’ve been reading stories and doing activities around the holidays. We will have two more Sunny Sundays- November 20 and December 12.

Our BeWise program for K-2 has brought children back into the building for learning and celebration. Some of our children are even coming on Shabbat, and learning looks a little different. There is no writing or coloring, crafting or gluing. Instead, they are acting and singing and learning in a whole new way. Religious education as we know it is becoming a new adventure through the town, rather than the same path it has always taken.

As the seasons change and the carousel moves us away from fall and into the start of winter, we are getting very excited about Thanksgiving and an early Hanukkah this year. We will be celebrating all there is to be thankful for and bringing a bit of history into it as well... of course in a developmentally appropriate manner! We are also working on on a special Keshet Hanukkah Party on Shabbat. If the weather permits, we will do something outside, so parents can attend. If not, we will Zoom everyone in for songs and celebrations.

We look forward to seeing you at our Hanukkah Party on December 5. There will be special activities geared for early childhood.

Each season brings different moments of wonder and awe with our children! Let’s slow down that carousel of time and enjoy these moments with them!

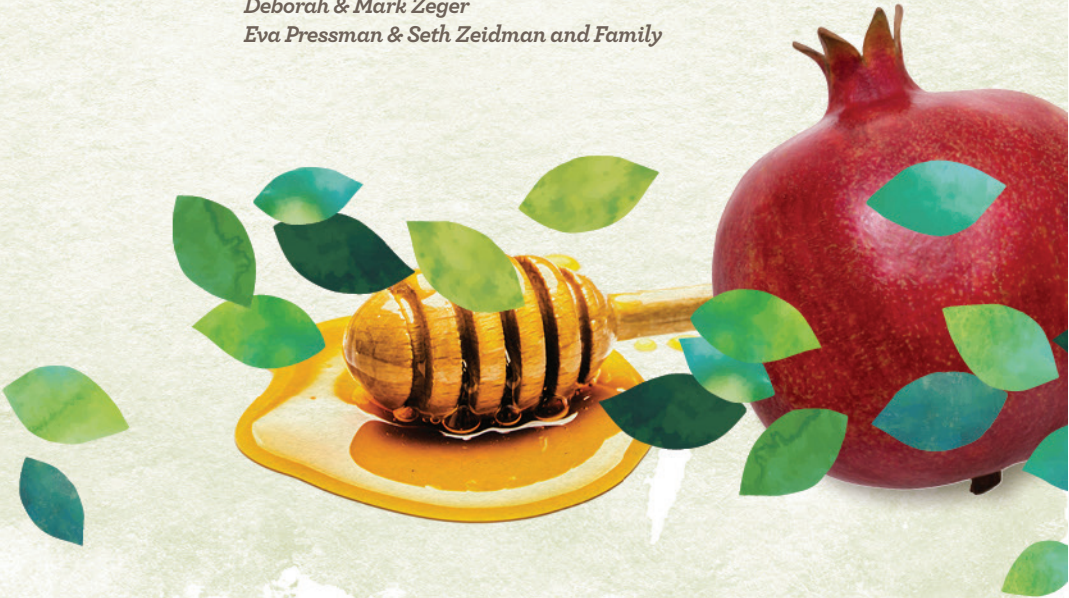

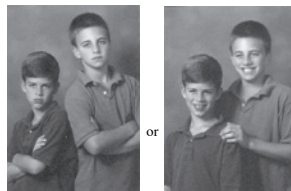
