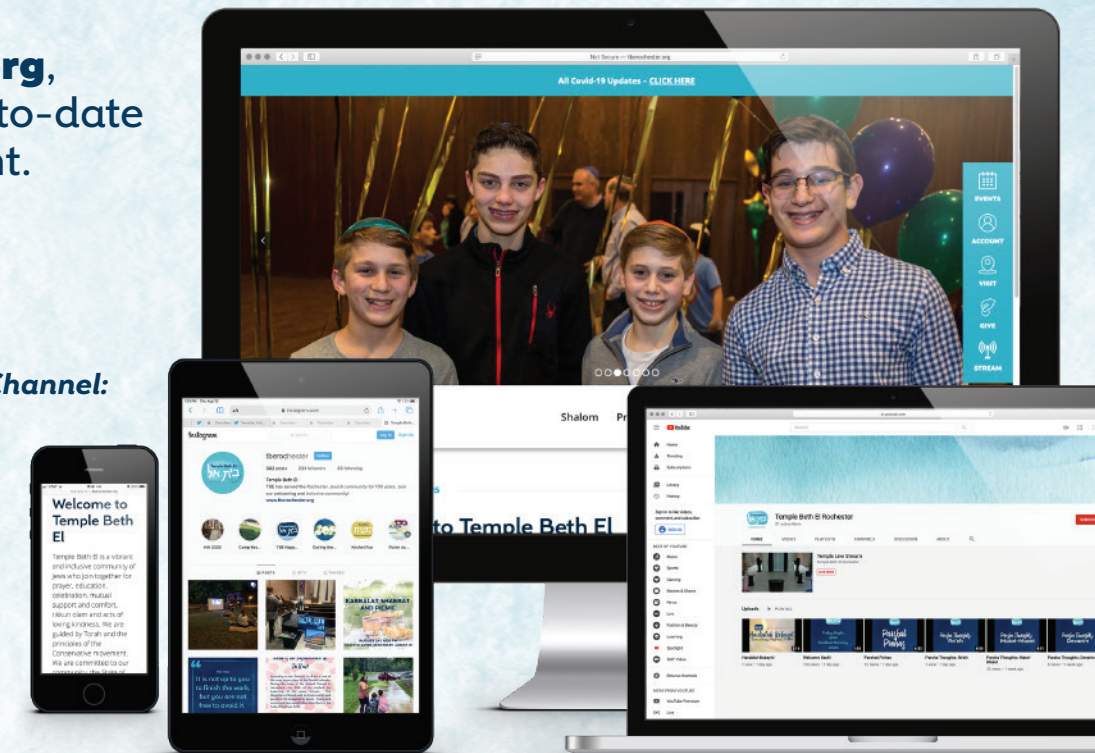

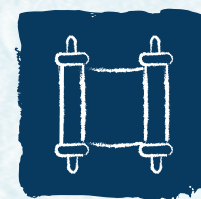

FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT

On the High Holy Days, I was honored to greet the congregation, where I posed some questions first on Rosh Hanahah and again at Kol Nidrei.

On Rosh Hashanah I asked: When did Jews become an urban people? When I think today of my four great-grandfathers, all of them immigrants, I count a cobbler, a rabbi, a tailor, and the owner of a small general store on the Boston Post Road in White Plains. In the still-gendered world of my grandparents, I count a lawyer and the manager of a shoe heel factory. My father is an orthodontist and my mother was trained as a teacher. No one in my family was a farmer. I could go back many generations, to shtetls in Eastern Europe, and there’s not a farmer in the lot. All of them lived in towns, working at some trade or another.

On Kol Nidrei I asked: Why are you here? Or maybe, for each of us, the right question to ask is, Why am I here?

We have busy lives. The world, frankly, is a mess right now. There is so much work out there that we need to do, and yet we are here.

No one made us come. On the contrary, getting here, on a weeknight, after a workday or a school day, rushing through dinner before the sun began to set, is a genuine inconvenience. I was teaching a seminar this afternoon—on race, history, and urban politics—and didn’t get to leave campus until after 5:00. Driving home, my mind was racing. What would we eat? How much time would I have to get this suit on, bowtie and all? But we are here. We made a choice to be here.

Each of us chose freely to be here, and each of us came to this decision in our own way.

FROM THE DESK OF THE SENIOR RABBI

I grew up without Thanksgiving because I was born in Chile (not Chili), but in America, Thanksgiving, is an important holiday. It is perhaps the only spiritual day that was created by our culture. The Pilgrims regarded themselves as the heirs of Bnei Israel. England to them was Egypt, crossing the Atlantic Ocean was the Red Sea. It was an escape from bondage. The New World was the Promised Land. Even with a meager harvest, they ordained a festival of Thanksgiving, a delayed Sukkot if you will.

What lessons does Thanksgiving teach us as Jews and as Americans? From the Talmud we learn that only ONE sacrifice alone would be mandatory even at Messianic times—the Thanksgiving offering. The Rabbis realized that a formal expression of gratitude to God would be essential to humans, even in a perfect Messianic society. And that is because without a grateful spirit, we only exist. We do not truly live. The word Yehudi (Jew) comes from the word Hoda’ha, thankfulness. To live as a Jew is to live with a sense of gratitude for every day we receive. We are constantly enriched by the achievement of others. We are born into a world and sustained by a society that was built and nurtured by the generations that preceded us. We should all be grateful.

Albert Einstein was not just an outstanding scientist but a great thinker. He said he was a borrower and declared that all of us are borrowers from life. He wrote “many times a day I realize how much my own inner and outer life is built on the layouts of my fellow friends, both living and dead, and how earnestly I must exert myself to give in return as much as I have received.” We must recognize at this time of the year the nobody is self-made. We are all indebted to the many who shaped our lives and made us what we are. Thanksgiving and Judaism reminds us that we need to be grateful for the things we take for granted and for all the things we forget.

It would have been so easy for the pilgrims of 1621 to focus on what they didn’t have. For Judaism, today, tomorrow, or each day is an opportunity to express our thanks. In the words of Psalms – *Hodu La’Adonai ki tov...* Give thanks to God for it is good.

May we each know the goodness of the day, and as we sit to eat our turkey (which in modern Hebrew is the same word—*hodu*), may we know good is our bounty and how great is our blessing.

Our children and families are coming back and spending quality time together in various domains.

Keshet began the year, with as I mentioned in my last article, record breaking numbers. The children have settled in beautifully, and we were thrilled to have our first Annual Sukkot with My Special

Guest. This program took the place of Apples with Abba and Etrogs with Ima and made it more inclusive and less demanding on working families. Our families came together to celebrate Sukkot and do an activity with their child's classes. It was a magical experience, and brought the normalcy that we've all been craving. We also hosted our first in-person Open House since 2019. It brought parents together and helped them to understand the curriculum in their child's classroom as well as meeting other parents.

BE WISE began strong with over 60 students registering for this program. We are currently offering 12 different classes, and are looking forward to the next minimester where we can offer even more. For our teens, we had an exciting Teen Sukkah Hop. Combined with Temple Sinai and Temple B'rith Kodesh, we brought teens together in a limousine. They went to all three synagogues and noshed and learned together in each other's Sukkah. This new annual tradition made memories for all who attended and blossomed friendships from across our Jewish community.

Stay tuned for updates on our various programs that you've grown to love, including Sunny Sundays and Shabbat playdates for our youngest congregants, Hanukkah programming for all ages, special teen events including a Shabbaton, and several more to come. HAZZAN MATT AUSTERKLEIN

Matt Austerklein is a prayer leader, musician, and scholar exploring the religious meaning of Jewish musical forms.

A congregational cantor for over a decade, Matt has worked in diverse pastoral, lifecycle, and

educational settings. He serves as a mentor to new and student cantors, and works on projects shaping the Jewish musical future.

Matt is a multi-genre artist of contemporary and classic Jewish music. He is currently a PhD candidate in Jewish Studies at Halle-Wittenberg University (Germany), where he is writing his dissertation on the professionalization of Ashkenazi cantors in early modern Europe.

In 2011 Matt was a recipient of the Richard W. Briskin Cantor-in-Residence Award.

RABBI ELYSSA AUSTERKLEIN

Rabbi Elyssa Austerklein is an artist, yogi, musician, and Founding Director of Ivrim Jews Without Borders. She is a graduate of Brandeis University, BU School of Theology, and the Rabbinical School of Hebrew College. Rabbi Elyssa has published in The Forward, eJewish Philanthropy, the journal Kerem, has contributed several times to the "Ask the Rabbis" section in Moment Magazine, and has a poem published in the volume When We Turned Within: Reflections on COVID-19. She is a trained mikveh guide, has led Hallel with Women of the Wall in Jerusalem, and was a "rabbi on the road" for the Institute of Southern Jewish Life. Rabbi Elyssa is a Rabbis Without Borders Fellow, and was named one of America's 33 most inspiring rabbis of 2015 by The Forward. She has held pulpits in Conservative and Reform congregations in Florida, Ohio, Maryland and Alaska. She is a devoted wife and mother.

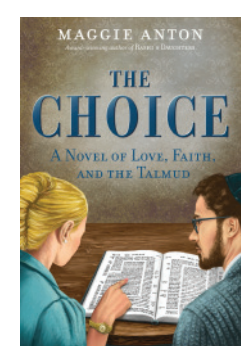

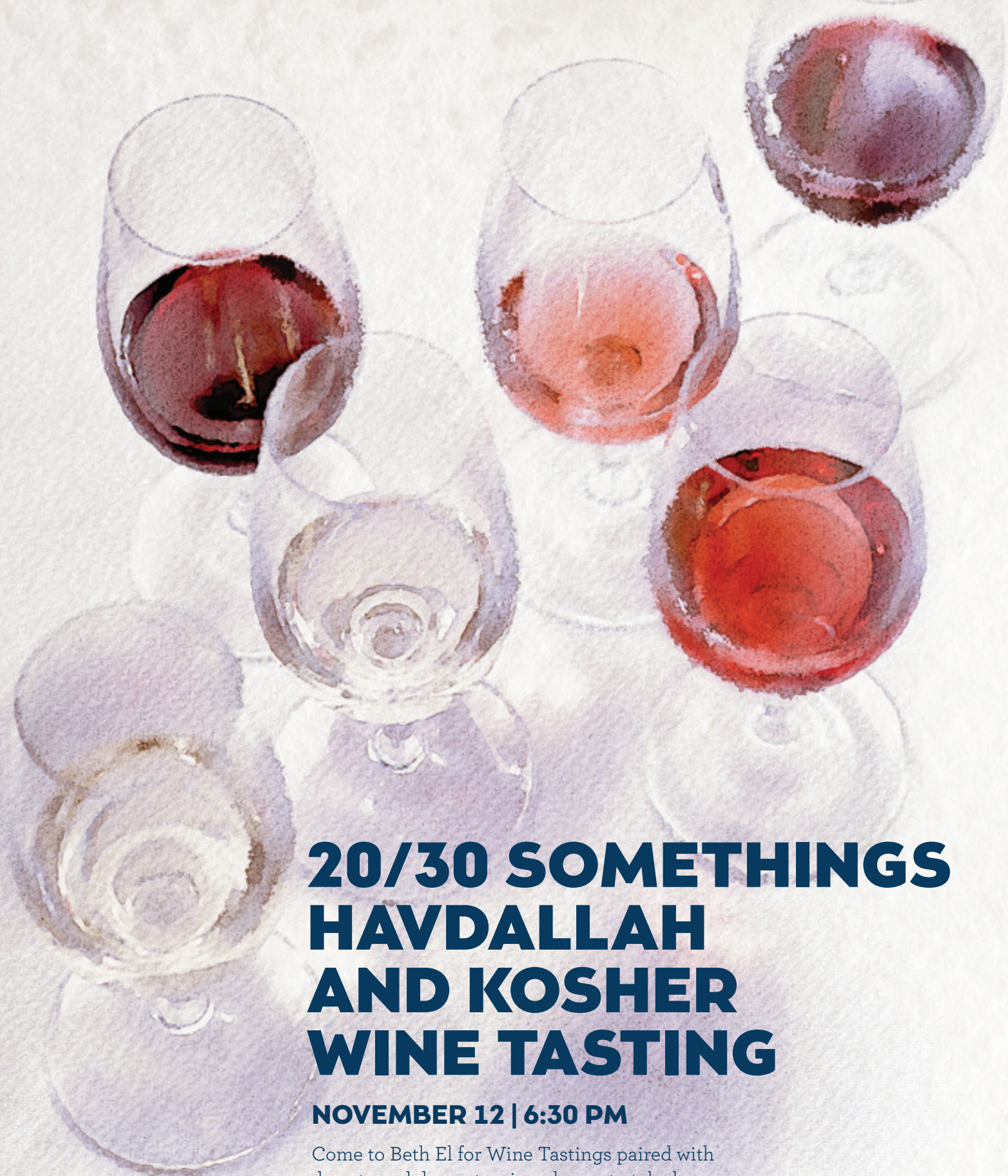
